New Workforce Rental Housing in Fishkill

FISHKILL - A new housing complex opened in the Town of Fishkill, Friday. Views at Rocky Glen is specially designed to provide affordable rentals for the local workforce. New residents joined Commissioner Brian Lawlor of New York State's Division of Housing and Community Renewal, Supervisor Joan Pagones of Fishkill, and many local officials



who gathered to cut the ribbon on the Views at Rocky Glen off Route 52 in the Town of Fishkill.

"The Views at Rocky Glen is an exceptional development that will provide comfortable and safe affordable housing for working families in Dutchess County", Commissioner Lawlor noted. "This project also demonstrates the importance of forming partnerships between the public and private sectors. We have worked with Regan Development in the past and this property is another example of their commitment to creating quality developments that improve the lives of residents.
